Sustainable Marine's new PLAT-I 6.40 platform is currently being assembled in Meteghan. It will be launched in January and then installed at the Grand Passage site for commissioning and testing throughout the winter and spring. It will be deployed to the Fundy Ocean Research Centre (FORCE) in 2021.

The current platform will be moved prior to the arrival of the new PLAT-I 6.40 in Grand Passage.

Sustainable Marine will also be installing its submarine cable to the substation in January. It will run from the platform to the substation in Freeport. Preparation will take about two days and one day to lay the cable. Support vessels will be in the harbour for both the preparation and the laying of the cable.
